Purpose of the Report

The present the Annual Report 2013/14 for approval and subsequent publication.

1 Report Details

- 1.1 The Council has an established Performance Management Framework which generates and presents quarterly reports to members and officers. This is as a part of the quarterly budget, Finance, Risk, and Performance Directorate meetings which scrutinises each service.
- 1.2 As a part of this framework Cabinet receives quarterly reports that monitor progress against the key initiatives and priorities of the Corporate Plan. These reports are produced on an exception basis and highlight under-performance. Recommendations to address under achievement are made within the report.
- 1.3 The Annual Report consolidates the quarterly monitoring and reporting framework to provide a summary of the performance of services, the related expenditure and extent that the Councils priorities are achieved over the year.

2 Conclusions and Reasons for Recommendation

- 2.1 The Annual Report is produced as a part of the Councils Policy Framework and provides a range of information that demonstrates the achievements made during the year against the Corporate Plan.
- 2.2 The range of information relates to the performance of services and key achievements as well as expenditure against service areas including details of income and revenue streams.

4 Alternative Options and Reasons for Rejection

4.1 Since the abolition of the Audit Commission there is no longer a statutory framework or requirement for local authorities to produce an annual statement related to the performance of services through a set of performance indicators.
