Executive and Non-Executive Appointments for the 2019-20 Municipal Year.

Report of the Joint Head of Corporate Governance and Monitoring Officer

Purpose of the Report

• To identify those Outside Bodies which should be classed as 'Executive' appointments and those which should be classed as 'Non-Executive' appointments for the 2019-20 municipal year.

1 Report Details

- 1.1 The Committee has previously agreed in principle to the adoption of a split between the appointment to outside bodies which relate to executive functions and those which relate to non-executive functions. It was explained that many local authorities had recognised that there is a clear distinction between Outside Bodies whose activities are relevant to executive side functions or the wider representative role played by Councillors.
- 1.2 There are a variety of ways in which this distinction is then reflected in appointments to these bodies. Some authorities make a distinction between Executive and Non-Executive appointments as part of the appointment process and in particular, ask their Cabinets to make Executive appointments and full Council to make Non-Executive appointments.
- 1.3 Committee also agreed the clear criteria that would be required for grouping those bodies to be appointed by Cabinet and those to be appointed by Council. The criteria was considered by Committee in October 2018 and is set out below:

OUTSIDE BODIES - EXECUTIVE SIDE FUNCTIONS TO BE APPOINTED BY CABINET:

- (i) There is an explicit legal or constitutional requirement that the Executive represent the Authority on the external organisation;
- (ii) The external organisation works directly with the Authority or its activities impact on the provision or Executive-side services;
- (iii) Membership of the external organisation enables the Authority to project political influence of helps to achieve its corporate goals and objectives.

OUTSIDE BODIES – NON EXECUTIVE SIDE FUNCTIONS TO BE APPOINTED BY COUNCIL

- (i) The external organisation has a minimal impact on the Executive-side services or functions of the Authority;
- (ii) The external organisation provides an opportunity for local Councillors to engage with their communities and to promote community empowerment;
- (iii) Membership of the external organisation needs to reflect the political balance of the Council as a whole:
- (iv) The external organisation carries out functions which could potentially impact on the Council's reserved, regulatory or scrutiny functions.
- 1.4 The criteria has now been applied to those Outside Bodies which the Council appointed to in May 2018, in order to categorise those which should be classed in the future as Executive Appointments and those which should be treated as Non-Executive Appointments.
- 1.5 The suggested grouping of the Outside Body appointments is appended to the report. If the Committee endorse this then Council and Cabinet would then be asked to approve the methodology and suggested allocation of responsibility for the specific appointments for the 2019-20 municipal year.

2 Conclusions and Reasons for Recommendation

- 2.1 Participation by Members in the work of Outside Bodies is important to the District Council, to these bodies and to the wider community. By being represented on Outside Bodies the Council can build links with local people and improve their capacity to work together on behalf of their communities.
- 2.2 The proposed approach should help to provide greater clarity about the purpose of individual appointments, their value to the Council and judging who the most appropriate appointees might be.
- 2.3 A survey has been carried out of those elected Members who serve on Outside Bodies. The early returns suggest that some of them have not been fully clear about their appointments and have had limited contact with the Outside Bodies to which have been appointed. Some are unable to judge the value of their participation in these Bodies. Setting clear appointment criteria for Executive and Non-Executive appointments will provide the individual Members appointed to these bodies, Council and Cabinet the benchmarks to make these judgements which are currently lacking.

3 Consultation and Equality Impact

3.1 None specific. Member participation in Outside Bodies provides local groups and other organisations an opportunity to engage with the Council and for Members to engage with them.

4 Alternative Options and Reasons for Rejection

4.1 The current approach to appointing representatives to Outside Bodies could be retained. However, it would not provide the clarity and focus of the revised approach.
