#### ANNUAL COUNCIL

#### 1 Election of Chair of the Council for the Municipal Year 2018/19

#### 11 Operation of Urgency Rules and Thresholds for Key Decisions

The Council was required under legislation to report instances where Special Urgency Rules had been utilised in respect of Key Decisions. This was where it was impractical to give the requisite notice of Key Decisions before they were made.

Council were asked to note that no decisions had been taken over the previous 12 months under Special Urgency Rules.

At the same time the Council had a constitutional requirement to advise of those occasions when it had taken decisions where call-in provisions had been waived. The Council had taken two such decisions in the previous 12 months and details were given in the report.

Council noted that it was a requirement at its annual meeting to review the threshold for Key Decisions. A Key Decision was an Executive Decision which was likely to result in the Council incurring expenditure or making savings which were deemed as significant or a Decision that was significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working in the area comprising two or more wards within the District. In reference to Key Decisions the Council had previously decided that income or expenditure of £50,000 or more was deemed to be significant. The current thresholds for Key Decisions were recommended to continue and are as follows:-

- Revenue Income, Savings or Expenditure £100,000
- Capital Income or Expenditure £250,000

(1) The decisions taken over the past 12 months under Special Urgency Rules, attached as Appendix 1 to the report, be noted.

- (3) The financial thresholds for Key Decisions be maintained at £100,000 (Revenue) and £250,000 (Capital) be agreed.
