Background

- A new apprenticeship levy came into place in April 2017 to support the Government's plan to increase apprenticeship starts to 3 million by 2020.
- An Apprenticeship target was set for public sector bodies to have 2.3% of its workforce comprised of apprenticeships.
- The Apprenticeship Levy will be a levy on UK employers to fund new apprenticeships.
- The levy will be 0.5% of the pay bill, paid through PAYE
- Any UK employer, in any sector, with
 - a pay bill of more than £3 million per year is liable to pay the levy
