Clay Cross Town Deal Background

Clay Cross is one of a number of towns up and down the country that were invited to submit a Town Investment Plan to gain Government funding through the Town Deal process. As part of this, Clay Cross has been allocated £24.1m of funding to undertake a number of projects which are identified in the Clay Cross Investment Plan. These projects are:

Purpose of the Working Group

The Sharley Park Active Community Hub is an investment of approximately £20m to replace and improve the current NEDDC leisure centre site with a new facility for the community which provides a range of health, leisure and support services, in a facility integrated with the wider Sharley Park and town centre as a whole.

The project already has a long running steering group which has taken the project to where we are today. This working group takes over the role of the former steering group, taking the development forward to completion.

Whilst decision making for the scheme lies with the District Council as landowner, major investor and operator, the role of the steering group is to obtain the best local, regional and national expertise to ensure the facility is sustainable long-term and best meets the needs of the community and strategic aims of stakeholders.
