REPORT DETAILS

- **Background** (reasons for bringing the report)
- 1.1 In line with the provisions within the Council's constitution, the Annual Meeting of Council is required to:
 - Appoint at least one Scrutiny Committee and other such committees as the Council considers appropriate to deal with matter which are neither reserved to the Council Meeting nor are Executive Functions;
 - Decide the size and terms of reference for those committees;
 - Decide the allocation of seats to political groups in accordance with the Political Balance rules.
- 1.2 The terms of reference for each Committee has been presented to the meeting as part of the Review of the Constitution.
- 1.3 The political balance was agreed at the meeting of Council on 16th November 2020. In light of the forthcoming by-election, it is suggested that no changes are considered to the number of seats allocated to groups until the next meeting of Council. Details of that decision are set out in **Appendix 1**.

2. <u>Details of Proposal or Information</u>

- 2.1 The size of each Committee is set out in **Appendix 1** to the report.
- 2.2 Political Groups are requested to nominate Members to serve on Committees and Advisory Groups (as set out in **Appendix 2**) with effect from 23 May 2022 for the 2022/23 Council year, understanding that amendments will be forthcoming at the following meeting when the outcome of the by-election is known.
- 2.3 The Committees are subject to the political balance requirements of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989. The Advisory Groups are not subject to the political balance requirements.

3 Reasons for Recommendation

- 3.1 The report recommends that the allocation of Committee seats detailed best meets the requirements of Section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act a far as reasonable practicable.
- 3.2 Nominations received in advance of the meeting from Political Groups are detailed in **Appendix 2**

4 Alternative Options and Reasons for Rejection

- 4.1 The Council may make amendments to the nominations to committees within the proportionality agreed before and up to the discussion of this matter at the Annual Meeting.
- 4.2 The Council is required by the provisions within its constitution to establish and appoint to committees at the annual meeting.
