Engagement of a Consultant to undertake an Electoral Review for both Bolsover and North East Derbyshire District Councils

The appointment of a temporary employee w.e.f. 2 March 2016 to carry out a review of Electoral Services within BDC and NEDDC.  The temporary contract is for approx 20-25 days over a 15 month period at a daily rate of £577 per day. It is anticipated that the maximum cost will be one of £15,000 split equally between the two Councils.  The cost will be met from the Transformation Reserve at BDC and from Invest to Save Reserve at NEDDC.	The Local Government Boundary Commission for England has advised that it intends to carry out a full review of the electoral arrangements in Bolsolver and NE Derbyshire.  Both elections teams have elections in May and an EU Referendum on 23 June, as well as County Council and possible Combined Authority Mayoral elections in 2017, together with the usual IER annual canvas arrangements.
