Purpose of the Report

• To establish and appoint Members to the Council's Committees and Advisory Groups for the 2019/20 municipal year.

1 Report Details

- 1.1 In line with the provisions within the Council's constitution, the Annual Meeting of Council is required to:
 - Appoint at least one Scrutiny Committee and other such committees as the Council considers appropriate to deal with matter which are neither reserved to the Council Meeting nor are Executive Functions;
 - o Decide the size and terms of reference for those committees:
 - Decide the allocation of seats to political groups in accordance with the Political Balance rules.
- 1.2 The terms of reference for each Committee has been presented to the meeting as part of the Review of the Constitution.
- 1.3 The size of each Committee is set out in **Appendix 2** to the report.
- 1.4 **Appendix 1** to the report sets out the allocation of committee seats which best meets the requirements of Section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 as far as is reasonably practicable.
- 1.5 Political Groups are requested to nominate Members to serve on Committees and Advisory Groups (as set out in **Appendix 2**) with effect from 20 May 2019 for the 2019/20 Council year.
- 1.6 The Committees are subject to the political balance requirements of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989. The Advisory Groups are not subject to the political balance requirements.

2 Conclusions and Reasons for Recommendation

- 2.1 The report recommends that the allocation of Committee seats detailed best meets the requirements of section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act a far as reasonable practicable.
- 2.2 Nominations have been received in advance of the meeting from all Political Groups and are detailed in **Appendix 2**.

- 3.1 Group Leaders have been consulted on the allocation of seats and nominations put forward.
- 3.2 An Equality Impact Assessment has not been necessary.
