Purpose of the Report

• To present NEDDC's Older People's Strategy 2020 to 2023 for formal approval by NEDDC Cabinet.

1 <u>Report Details</u>

- 1.1 This strategy has been developed in line with the Council's aim of enhancing our residents' quality of life identified as one of the priorities in our Council Plan 2019 2023.
- 1.2 It sets out the Council's vision and strategic priorities for supporting older people living in our District over the next 3 years and demonstrates our commitment to improving their lives and the opportunities available to them.
- 1.3 It considers various aspects of older people's lives including work and personal finances, health, access to leisure, safety, volunteering and social isolation and sits alongside our other strategies to underpin deliver of the Council Plan.
- 1.4 It will help inform how we will direct our limited resources to make the greatest positive impact for older people and contribute to our ambition to create a successful and sustainable District that will support people to feel safe, happy and healthy, and to prosper in communities they are proud to live and work in.

2 <u>Conclusions and Reasons for Recommendation</u>

- 2.1 The Strategy meets the Council Plan 2019 2023 commitment to develop an Older People's Strategy for the District.
- 2.2 The Strategy works in synergy with other Council strategies and existing service provision to underpin delivery of the Council Plan 2019 2023 priorities.

3 Consultation and Equality Impact

- 3.1 Consultation has been conducted internally with NEDDC Heads of Service and Service Managers, and externally with DCC, RHL Ltd and representative groups including Age Concern, DVA, Parish Councils and NEDDC-funded OAP Clubs.
- 3.2 The Strategy has been developed in line with the Council's Equality Impact Assessment Framework.

4 Alternative Options and Reasons for Rejection

4.1 An alternative option would be to not publish the Strategy, however this would mean that the Council fails to meet one of its commitments in the Council Plan 2019 – 2023, therefore this option has been rejected.

5 <u>Implications</u>

5.1 <u>Finance and Risk Implications</u>

- 5.1.1 There are no identified financial implications as the Strategy uses existing services and resources to deliver most of its outcomes. Actions will be linked to existing Service Plans and reported through the Council's existing performance management frameworks.
